Gregory Murphy (1914-1948); our Uncle, Reverend Monsignor Richard J. Murphy (1922-1997) and Our First Cousin (once removed), Reverend Robert Walsh (1918-2004).

Tables are set for 10 and the tickets are available for \$100.00 per person (\$1,000.00 per table). A partial tax receipt is available. Our goal is to have all the "Murphy family and friends tickets" sold by mid September.
